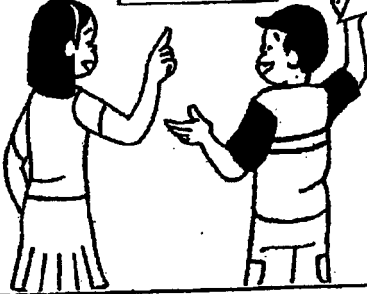

Write a composition of at least 150 words about a **difficult decision**.

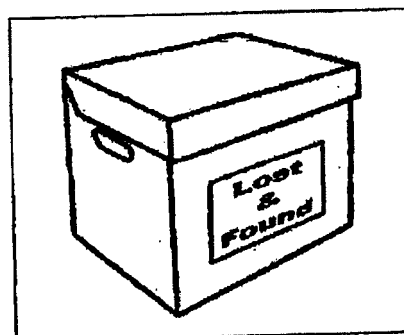
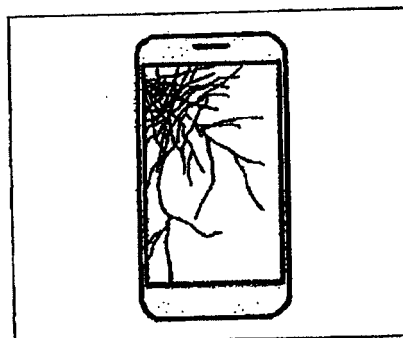
The pictures are provided to help you think about the topic.
