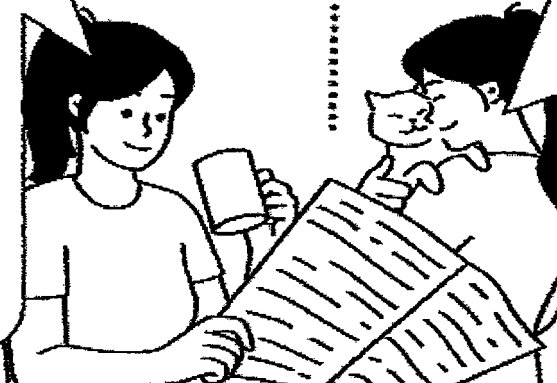


Cats
