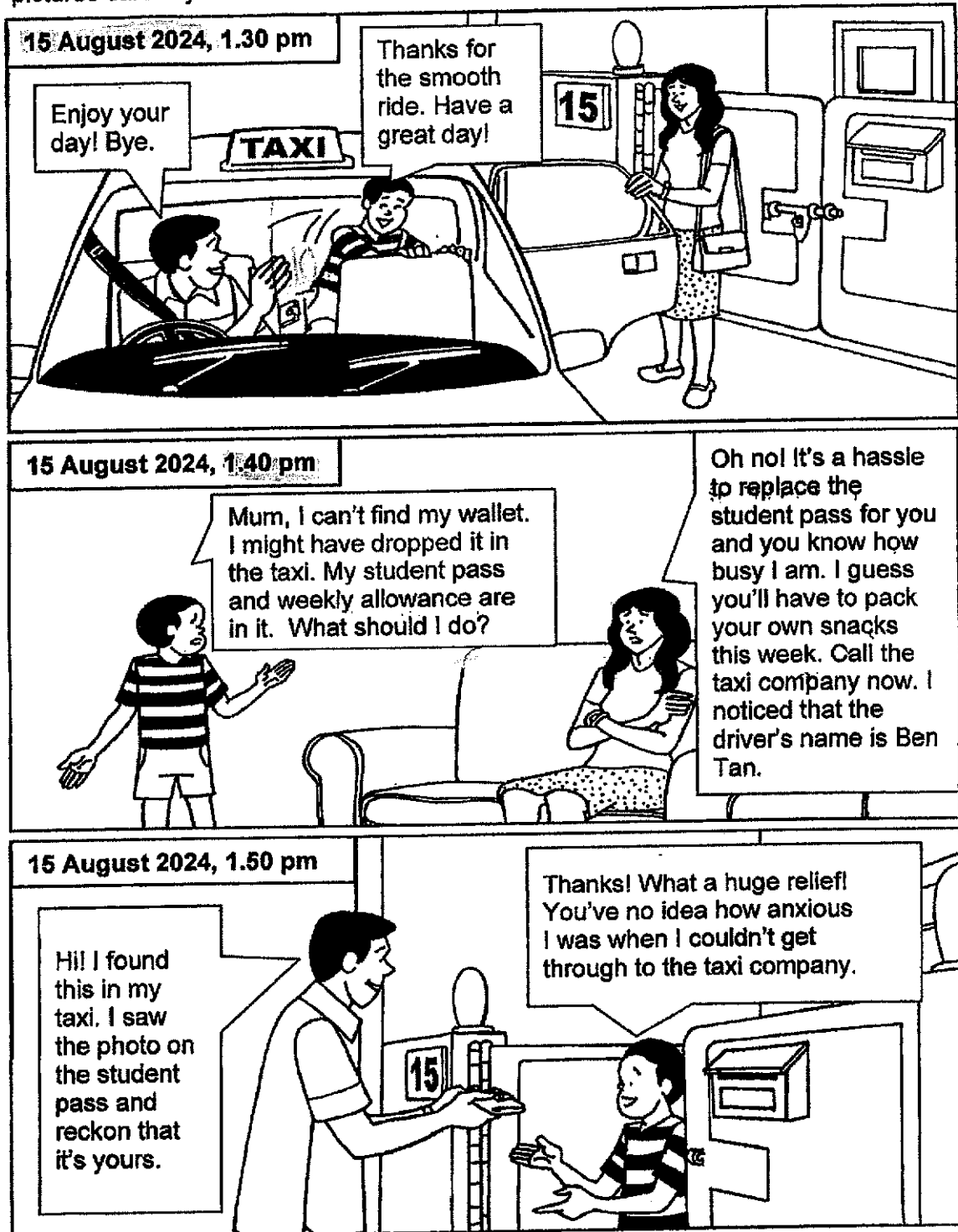

2. Write a composition of at least 150 words about **working hard for a reward**.

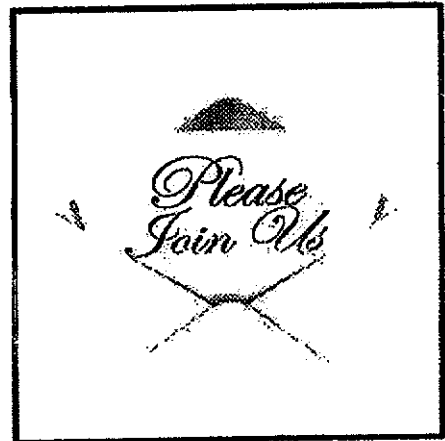
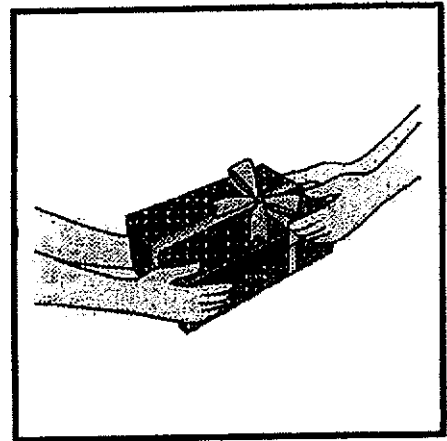
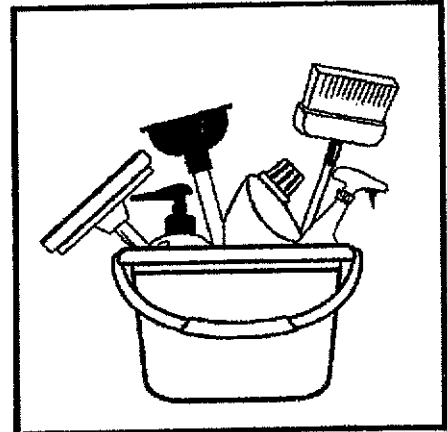
The pictures are provided to help you think about this topic.
